**A RESOLUTION FROM THE AD HOC COMMITTEE FOR A DRUG PREVENTION PROGRAM AND IMPLEMENTATION**

**Whereas**, an Ad Hoc Committee for a Drug Prevention Program and Implementation was created by the Blount County Commission with the passage of Resolution 22-06-012 and as amended by Resolution 22-10-012 for the purpose of creating a joint resolution to suggest a drug prevention education curriculum and implementation for the students of Blount County Schools; and

**Whereas**, the Ad Hoc Committee met publicly and agreed to officially recommend the curriculum from the National Institute on Drug Abuse, an agency of the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services; and

**Whereas**, it is deemed to be in the best interest of Blount County, to adopt the recommendation as requested.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Blount County Legislative Body, meeting in regular session this 17<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2022, that the Ad Hoc Committee request to adopt a no-cost, drug prevention program curriculum from the National Institute on Drug Abuse, an agency of the U.S. Department of Health, be implemented beginning January 1, 2023, in the Blount County School system of Blount County, Tennessee, for sixth grade students.
