## RESOLUTION OF THE BLOUNT COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF SURPLUS PROPERTY FROM THE BLOUNT COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT TO THE CITY OF FRIENDSVILLE

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated§ 12-2-420 (a) states that "Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, counties, municipalities and metropolitan governments may purchase, trade or receive as a gift, upon approval of the governing bodies involved in the transaction, any used or surplus personal property from another county, municipality, metropolitan government, state government, federal government or any instrumentality of the foregoing, without regard to any laws regarding public advertisement and competitive bidding. Also notwithstanding any other provision of law, any county, municipality, or metropolitan government may by resolution or ordinance of its governing body establish a procedure for the disposition of its surplus personal property to other governmental entities, including, but not limited to, counties, municipalities, metropolitan governments, the state of Tennessee, the federal government, other states or their political subdivisions and the instrumentalities of any of the foregoing, by sale, gift, trade, or barter upon such terms as the governing body may authorize, without regard to any other provisions of law regarding the sale or disposition of used or surplus personal property"; and

WHEREAS, the Blount County Highway Department, an agency of the local government of Blount County, Tennessee, possesses and has declared as surplus property (dump truck) and said equipment is no longer of use to the Blount County Highway Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Friendsville has expressed a desire to receive said vehicle; and

**WHEREAS,** Blount County is entitled under Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 12, Chapter 2 Part 420, to transfer such surplus equipment to another local governing body in this manner.

*NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED* by the Blount County Legislative Body assembled in regular session assembled this the <u>18<sup>th</sup></u> day of <u>January</u>, 2018, that the Sale of Surplus Equipment (Vehicles) is approved for Blount County, Tennessee.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, and that any part of any proper resolution to the contrary is hereby declared null and void, the public welfare requiring it.
