

ARPA Utility Projects Monthly Update – June 2026

- The Tuckaleechee Utility District (TUD) Water System project is in the construction closeout phase and should be completed by the end of July. The project will come in under budget. This project is funded by both TDEC and the County's direct American Rescue Plan (ARP) allocation.
- The South Blount County Utility District (SBCUD) Chilhowee View Road Water Main and Tuckaleechee Pike Water Main projects are completed, coming in ahead of schedule and under budget. These projects are funded by the County's direct ARP allocation.
- The SBCUD Town of Louisville water main project is completed, coming in ahead of schedule and under budget. This project is funded by both TDEC and the County's direct ARP allocation.
- The Knox Chapman Utility District (KCUD) Upgrade project is in the construction closeout phase and should be completed by the end of July. This project is funded by both TDEC and the County's direct ARP allocation.
- The City of Friendsville's water meter replacement project has been completed. The water line replacement project is in the construction closeout phase and should be completed by the end of July. These projects are funded by the County's direct ARP allocation as well as funding from TDEC and the City of Friendsville.
