RE: Property Surplus Sale

DATE: November 4, 2022

The 1957 Purchasing Act governs the sale of surplus real property. In accordance with the Act, we are requesting that Commission allow the Purchasing Department to sell as surplus the County-owned, property located in Maryville, Tennessee. The County wants to offer the sale of the Property through a public auction process in accordance with T.C.A. § 5-14-101, et. seq. The site is the current office for the Fifth Judicial Drug Task Force. If given permission to declare the property surplus, the County allow an auction company to auction the property. Upon sale of the property, the County will realize an increase in property tax revenue.

It is recommended the Commission adopt a Resolution declaring the property located in Maryville, Tennessee as surplus property and authorize its sale.
