WHEREAS, Blount County currently has a significant number of people addicted to opioids and are in need of a Substance Use Residential Treatment Facility; and

WHEREAS, The Helen Ross McNabb is requesting funding for three beds per day to increase local access to the Substance Use Residential Treatment Facility located in Blount County; and

WHEREAS, It is deemed to be in the best interest of Blount County, to amend the Fund Balance as requested.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Body of Blount County, Tennessee, assembled in regular/called session on this 16th day of July 2026.
