The revisions he mentioned included: the designation of dangerous dogs to be determined by the Blount County General Sessions Court; the addition of level one dangerous dogs designation; structured spay / neuter requirements; shelter / shade / environment requirements; guidelines for outdoor restaurants to allow service / emotional support animals; and guidelines for tethering dogs.

A motion was made by Board Member Koella, seconded by Board Member Ragon, that the revised ordinance be forwarded to full commission with a favorable recommendation. A voice vote was taken with all voting aye, and none opposed. The Chairman declared the motion to have passed.
