- 1. Background Recovery Court has case loads to support a third Treatment Specialist to provide the quality and consistent comprehensive clinical treatment needed for participants to be successful in recovery of opioid and substance abuse disorder.
- 2. History (tell if the item has been brought to the budget committee previously) We have needed a third Treatement Specialist in Recovery Court for a few years. Case loads average 60-70 per therapist which exceeds recommended best practices.
- 3. Current Operations (how are operations without the requested item/service) We currently have to limit frequency & length of sessions to provide opportunity for each participant to receive needed therapeutic services & limited class instruction time.
- 4. Proposal (what is the new item/service being requested) Contracting a third Treatment Specialist with HRM, trainings for current therapists, supplies, and ability to offer current trending opioid and substance abuse treatment practices and needs.
- 5. Impact if not funded (provide a summary on impact to the mission if the item/service is not approved) Evidence based treatments will be very limited due to time required to be effective. The legality of reactionary vs preventative services becomes an issue.
