## 2. School District Reports.

The Chair recognized Interim Director of Schools Dr. Teffeteller. She mentioned the school system transitioning to the newly hired director of schools, and the upcoming high school graduation ceremonies.

Supervisor of Facilities, Maintenance and Capital Projects James Duke pointed out the new secured entrance at Montvale Elementary. Other projects he mentioned included: William Blount roof repair/replcaement; WB CTE renovation; Heritage and WB High School track projects; and HHS Auditorium renovation (seating, curtains, lights and sound system). The school system's maintenance program was commended for their efforts.

Dr. Teffeteller discussed procuring Science textbooks and kits (\$2.1 million for classroom textbooks and a digital copyright for HS students). Instructional Supervisors Amanda Vance and Jon Young answered questions about the curriculum adoption process.

The Chair spoke about "Project SEARCH" a program for transitioning students with intellectual and developmental disabilities from high school into employment through internships at community businesses.
