**A PROCLAMATION HONORING QUENTIN CALDWELL FOR HIS DEDICATED SERVICE TO

BE IT PROCLAIMED, by the Board of Commissioners of Blount County, Tennessee, in regular session assembled this ____ day of _____, 2026:

WHEREAS, Quentin Caldwell began his tenure as the Blount County Commissioner for the Seventh (7) Commission District - Seat A after being nominated and appointed on November 21, 2024; and
