WHEREAS, Curtis Moore has dedicated more than five decades of exemplary service to law enforcement, corrections, and public safety, demonstrating unwavering professionalism, integrity, and commitment to the citizens and communities he has served; and

WHEREAS, Curtis Moore began his public safety career with the City of Knoxville, serving at the Knoxville Airport beginning in 1973, where he established a strong foundation of service and dedication to protecting the public; and

WHEREAS, in 2003, Curtis Moore transitioned to Court Services, where he continued to serve with distinction for the remainder of his tenure, earning the respect and admiration of judges, attorneys, fellow officers, court personnel, and citizens alike through his professionalism, dependability, and dedication; and

WHEREAS, throughout his career with the Blount County Sheriff's Office, Curtis Moore was recognized twice as Employee of the Month, reflecting his exceptional work performance, positive attitude, and commitment to excellence; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, Curtis Moore was honored as a Local Hometown Hero by WIMZ and Food City, a testament to his outstanding service, community impact, and the high regard in which he is held by both his colleagues and the public; and

WHEREAS, after a remarkable career spanning more than fifty years in public service and law enforcement, Curtis Moore now retires, leaving behind a legacy of dedication, honor, professionalism, and selfless service that will continue to inspire future generations of public safety professionals;
