A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE ZONING RESOLUTION OF BLOUNT COUNTY, TENNESSEE BY MODIFING ARTICLE 13 TO REVISE THE DEFINITION OF DAYCARE CENTER.		
<b>BE IT RESOLVED,</b> by the Board of Commissioners of Blount County Tennessee, in session assembled this day of, 2023:		
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Legislature of the State of Tennessee has enabled Blount County to adopt and amend zoning regulations in Tennessee Code Annotated Section 13-7-101, <i>et seq.</i> , and		
WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Blount County, Tennessee adopted zoning regulations in Resolution 00-06-010 A RESOLUTION ADOPTING ZONING IN BLOUNT COUNTY PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 13-7-101, et seq., OF THE TENNESSEE CODE ANNOTATED, and		
WHEREAS, the Blount County Regional Planning Commission has determined that the definition of daycare center found in the zoning regulations should be revised to include provision for adult day care; and		
WHEREAS, the County Attorney's office has recommended further changes to align the definition with applicable State statutes; and		
WHEREAS, the Blount County Regional Planning Commission met in regular session on, 2023, and voted to recommend that the County Commission approve the following amendment to the zoning regulations; and		
WHEREAS, the Alcoa Regional Planning Commission also met in regular session on, and voted to recommend that the County Commission the following amendment to the zoning regulations; and		
<b>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED</b> , BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BLOUNT COUNTY, TENNESSEE, to adopt the following:

That Article 13 be amended as follows:		
DAY CARE CENTER: Any child care arrangement that provides day care on a regular basis for more than four hours per day for more than five children of preschool age and meets requirements for licensing by the state of Tennessee. Any arrangement that provides care or supervision services for at least three (3) hours per day to five (5) or more children or adults		

who are not related to the primary caregiver and meets the requirements for licensing by the state of Tennessee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE IN FORCE AND BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON ITS ADOPTION, THE PUBLIC WELFARE REQUIRING IT.
