Public Lobby: Clean

Hallways: Clean

Intake: General area – Housekeeping is good, Offices clean, Primary (officers) Bathroom, clean; Both showers have new floor mats, which is a great resolve until showers can be upgraded. The shower area is clean empty paper shower cups on the floor.

Cell#1 – Occupied, cell is clean except trash is on the floor and it needs to be mopped. No noticeable maintenance issues noted. Cell #2 – Occupied, cell has trash on the floor, the floor drain also needs to be cleaned out. No maintenance issues noted. Cell #3 – Empty and is not yet cleaned. No maintenance issues noted. Cell #4- Occupied, floor needs to be cleaned and tissue paper removed from ceiling air vent. No maintenance issues noted. Cell #5 (Sallyport and pre-processing) The car wash area is clean, supplies organized and stored. No vehicles are being washed at the time of this visit. Cell #6 is occupied, and has been cleaned. No maintenance issues noted. Cell #7 – Supply Area for Car Wash Crew, is clean and organized and no maintenance issues are noted. Fingerprint area, stained ceiling tiles need to be replaced, no other issues noted. Cell#8- Occupied and has been cleaned. No maintenance issues noted. Cell #9 – Occupied and is clean except the floor drain needs to be cleaned out. Cell #10 – has been converted into a virtual courtroom (not in use during this visit) needs to be swept. Cell #11 – Serves a dual purpose as Lawyer/Client Interview Room and virtual courtroom. It is not in use at the time of this visit and is clean.

*ONGOING ISSUES: stained ceiling tile.

Medical: Exam #1 – Not in use at the time of this visit, floor needs to be swept and mopped. No maintenance issues noted.

Exam #2 – Is now used as a supply room, counter and sink are dirty and floor needs to be swept. No maintenance issues noted.

Pharmacy: Locked, did not inspect.

- M-2 This is the decontamination area; Area is clean except the floor.
- M-3 Occupied and is dirty. Food waste and Styrofoam containers thrown around the cell. Cell needs a thorough cleaning. The floor, pie hole and door needs to be cleaned both inside and outside.
- M-4 Occupied, and the cell is clean except there is tissue paper stuck to the ceiling light fixture & air vent. Both are completely covered.
- M-5 Occupied, and is clean except the door and pie hole need to be cleaned.
- M-6 –Occupied, and is clean. No maintenance issues noted.
- M-7 Occupied and cell is clean. No maintenance issues noted.
- M-8 This cell is occupied and clean. No hot water in this particular cell.

M-9 Occupied, The cell is occupied and clean. No maintenance issues noted.

M-10–Is occupied and clean. Light cover needs to be cleaned or replaced.

Hallway floors need to be cleaned/mopped and trash cans need to be emptied.

The shower is not in use and is clean.

Nurses offices clean and organized, and the office used for dental hygiene is locked, did not inspect.

NOTE: **Medical continues to be cold and damp. Air circulation needs to be improved, and extra blankets issued.

Inmate Complaints.

*Inmate Rhonda Robinson, reports that she has been held since 2/16/23 and has not received a visit from her court appointed attorney and that her court dates have been reset multiple times without her being notified as to why. She states that she is in danger of losing her bed placement (if she hasn't already) for treatment.

Classroom: Clean and orderly

Kitchen: Food storage area – stands in need of additional shelving space. Cleaning was in progress. No issues noted during this visit and no complaints or needs were registered. *Exhaust hood over the stove needs to have the dry sprinkler system replaced.

Laundry: Clean- No laundry being done during this visit. The middle dryer is down for repairs, waiting for parts.

Library: Orderly (it is a shared space with equipment storage). Could use a dedicated space.

Dinner delivery was in progress.

Staff Offices are clean and organized.

Outside Recreation Yard: No standing water issues and not maintenance issues noted.

Multipurpose Room: No in use at the time of this visit. The carpet needs to be vacuumed.

C-Pod Hallways: Clean, large trash cans will be emptied by nighttime pod workers. Dinner delivery in progress.*

NOTES: The wall cracks in C-16 has no noticeable changes. The cracks appear worse in winter due to thermocycling.

Hot water has been restored, but some areas are experiencing issues.
