## Budget Theme

#### Staff Retention and Compensation

- Pay equity is being impacted by actions of surrounding communities
- Completed compensation and classification review
- Based on market survey and NOT an "across the board" solution

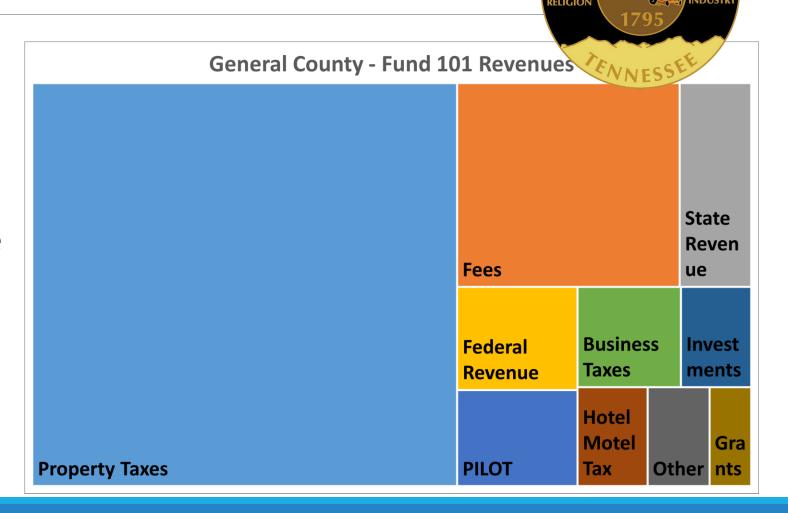
## Budget Details - Revenue

- Adjusted to \$646,000

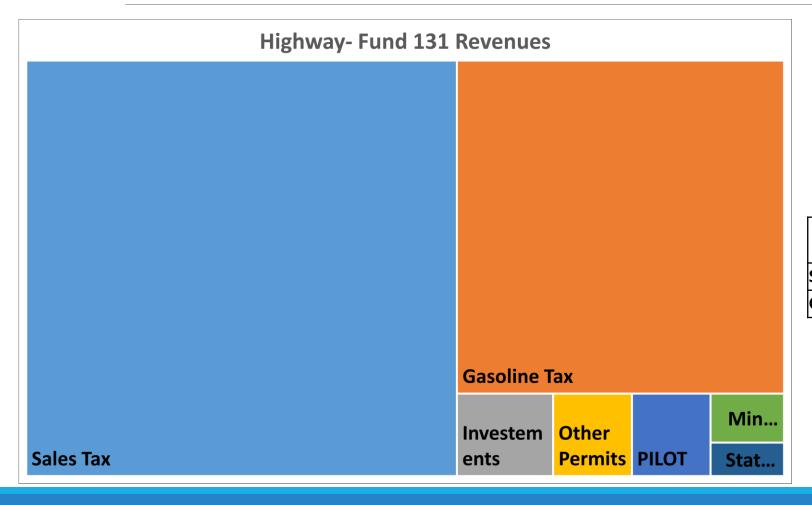
#### Blount County Sheriff's Office

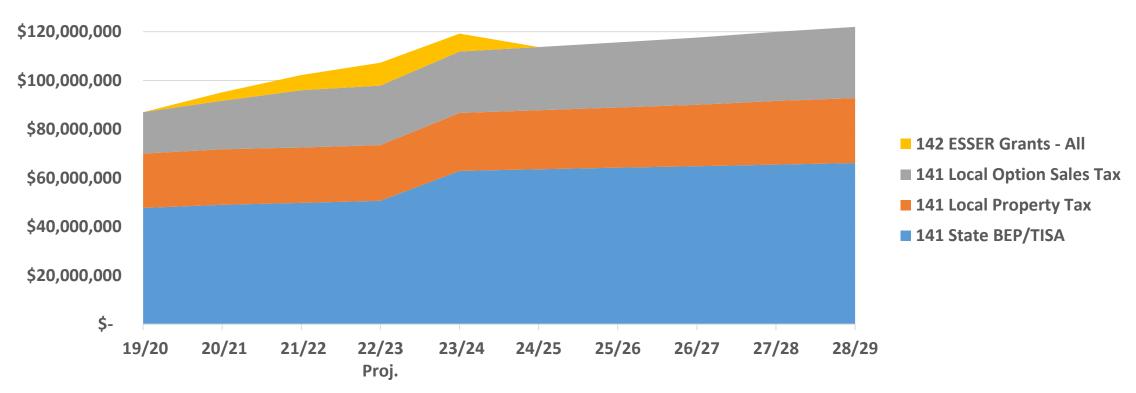
#### Sales & Gasoline Tax Trend

- Capital Resolution

## Recommended Tax Levy in Excess

#### **Property Reappraisal**

- 4 Year Reappraisal Cycle with last reappraisal in 2019
- Oversight and Approval by the Comptroller's Office

#### Reappraisal Results

- Median House Value in Blount County increased by an average of 76%
- From \$185,000 to \$325,000
- This does NOT mean property taxes will go up by the same percentage
- On average, a homeowner will pay approximately \$13 a month more at the Certified Rate

## Recommended Tax Rate Allocation



Certified Rate – Estimated at \$1.5932 / Recommended \$1.60

Proposed Rate – \$1.69, or 6% increase over the Certified Rate

On average, a homeowner will pay approximately \$19 a month more at the Proposed Rate

### Fund Balance



#### FUND BALANCES AS OF 6/30/22

101 General County: \$45.3M (\$33.9M unassigned)

131 Highway: \$12.3M (roughly \$6M appropriated in asphalt and bridge work)

141 General Purpose Schools: \$21.1M (\$12.1M unassigned)

151 Debt Service: \$27.7M (\$12M loaned to schools for ECCA construction)
