**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
BLOUNT COUNTY, TENNESSEE AND TOWNSEND, TENNESSEE
RELATIVE TO KINZEL SPRINGS ROAD BRIDGE**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Blount County, Tennessee, in session assembled January 17, 2019.

WHEREAS, Blount County, Tennessee (hereinafter "Blount County") is the owner of the Kinzel Springs Road Bridge in Townsend, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Blount County has previously determined that Kinzel Springs Road Bridge is no longer structurally sound for the purposes of automobile and motorized traffic and it was determined that it would be more economically feasible to rehabilitate the Kinzel Springs Road Bridge for the purpose of pedestrian and bicycle traffic only rather than completely demolishing the bridge; and

WHEREAS, Townsend, Tennessee (hereinafter "Townsend") has agreed to lease and maintain said property for the purposes of pedestrian and bicycle traffic for citizens and visitors of the Townsend area; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Blount County that the Kinzel Springs Road Bridge be used for the purposes of pedestrian and bicycle traffic.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Blount County, Tennessee, that the Lease Agreement relative to the Kinzel Springs Road Bridge between Blount County, Tennessee and Townsend, Tennessee, which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by reference, is approved and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of Blount County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT FROM AND AFTER PASSAGE, THE PUBLIC WELFARE REQUIRING IT.
