#### **ROLL CALL**

BE IT REMEMBERED, that a meeting of the Blount County Education Committee was held on Tuesday, June 4, 2019, at 12:00 PM at Blount County Schools Central Office in Maryville, Tennessee. Education Committee Chairman Dodd Crowe called the meeting to order. The roll call was taken by the Chairman. There were 5 present and 4 absent. The Chairman declared there to be a quorum. In addition to the Education Committee members, others present were: Rob Britt -Director of Blount County Schools; Troy Logan - Fiscal Administrator; Terry "Mutt" Baldwin - Maintenance Foreman; Board of Education members Diane Bain, Fred Goins, and Debbie Sudhoff; and County Commissioner Nick Bright. #### A. SETTING OF AGENDA.

A motion was made by Vice Chair Bowers, seconded by Commissioner Mikels, to set the agenda. A voice vote was taken. The Chairman declared the motion to have passed.

#### 1. Maintenance/Construction Report.

Terry "Mutt" Baldwin gave the Maintenance and Construction report of various projects at the schools to include installation of a new cooling tower at Prospect; the block building and storage shed were painted at Porter; installed new parking gates at Fairview; repaired a chiller leak at William Blount; installed a new vent system for boilers at Heritage High School. He also reported for the month of May there were 183 closed work orders, and 162 work orders in-progress. Current projects are the renovation and asbestos abatement at Everett Learning Opportunity Center; William Blount Career & Technical building re-roof; and a new sprinkler system and fence repairs at Eagleton. There was no action taken.

#### 2. Financial Report.

Troy Logan gave the Financial report that included an update of BCS year-end budget; BEP funding; and a resolution for leasing Chromebooks on the June 2019 Commission agenda. He reported that there are no budget amendments for June. There was no action taken.

#### E. UNFINISHED BUSINESS.

The Chairman reported that a resolution was passed at the May 16, 2019 Commission meeting to add School Board members as ex-officio, non-voting members to the Education Committee. The School Board will recommend two (2) of their members to the Commission for consideration.

Rob Britt did not give a report, but answered questions from the committee. Commissioner Mikels requested the student enrollment and capacity at each school.
