**RE:** Budget transfer for air purifier

**Date:** August 29, 2019

Attached is a budget transfer request for the Animal Control Budget to cover the cost of installing an air purifying system that would service the clinic area of the building.

This budget transfer is in the amount of \$8,210.00. The money would be coming out of our reserve donation money that is slated to be used for the betterment of the animal center and the care the animals receive. It would be moved from our use of fund line item to our other equipment line item. Currently the only room that had any type of air purification system installed is the surgery suite. No other room in the entire building has any type of air purification and one air conditioning and heating unit services several rooms. The area this air purification unit will take care of is the cat isolation, Dr. William's office (which is set up as a critical care unit), the Animal Control Office, the staff break room, and the vetting area. This purification unit will eliminate all air borne pathogens from being spread from one room to another including ringworm. There are several of these pathogens that are contagious and can be spread through the duct work. Cat isolation is used to house cats that are being treated for various health issues, this room is the first room the duct work goes through and continues through to the other rooms. If any air borne pathogens get into the duct work they can be quickly spread to healthy animals coming in through vetting (many of which are not up to date on their vaccines) or worse yet to an animal in Dr. Williams office that is in a very compromised situation requiring critical care. This unit will not only improve the care our animals receive it will also improve the air quality for our staff and volunteers.

As stated earlier this request is a transfer of money in our reserve and not an increase in our budget. Please let me know if you have any questions regarding this resolution request
