- 1. The building located on the property must be demolished and removed from the property within six (6) months.
- 2. The property herein conveyed may be used only for a parking lot and for no other purpose.
- 3. The parking lot constructed upon the property herein conveyed shall be open for use by the general public free of charge during normal operation hours of Blount County Government.

The purchaser of the property acknowledges the validity of the restrictive covenants imposed herein and further acknowledges that Blount County shall have the legal right to enforce and take all legal action necessary to enforce the Restrictive Covenants imposed herein."
